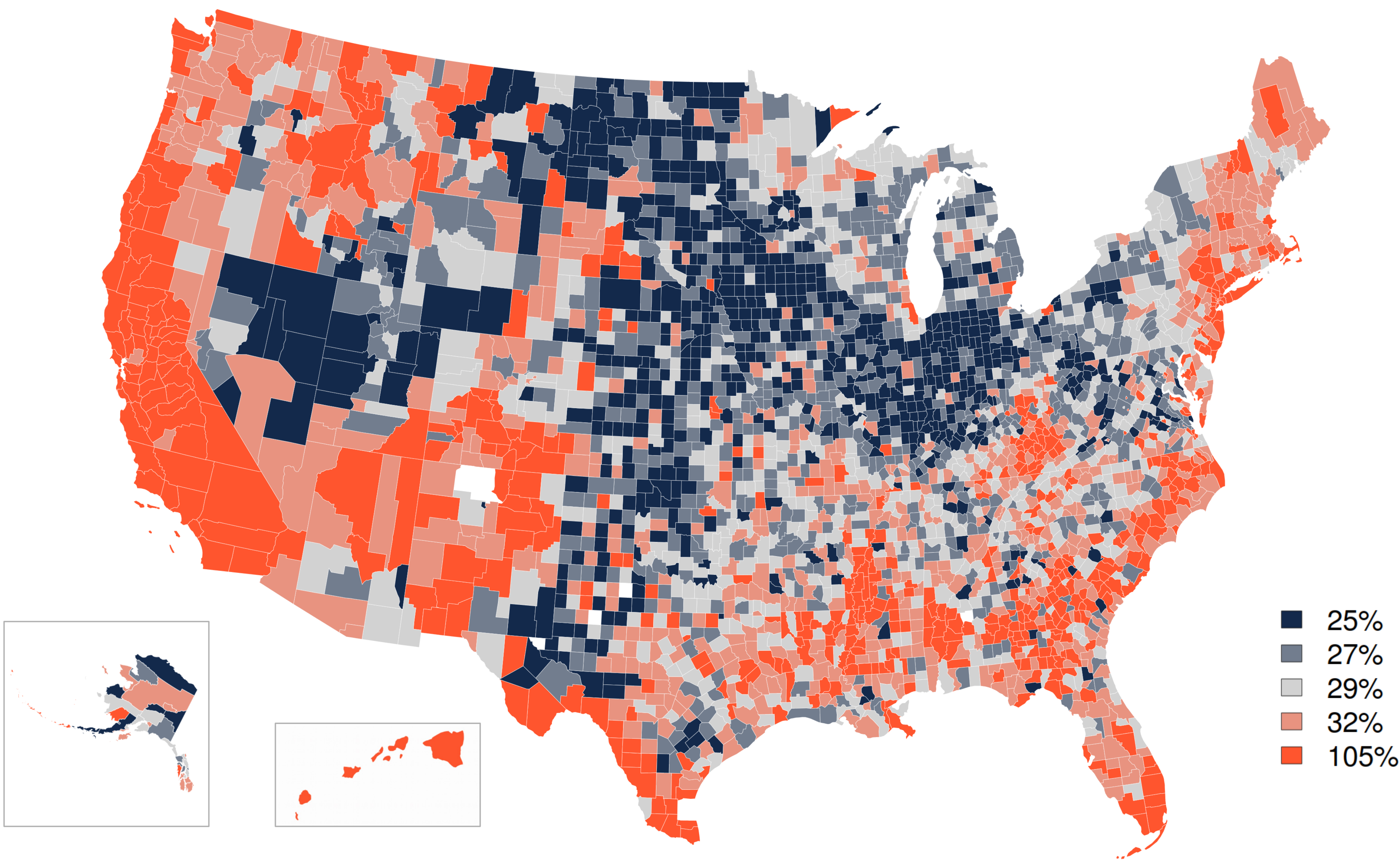

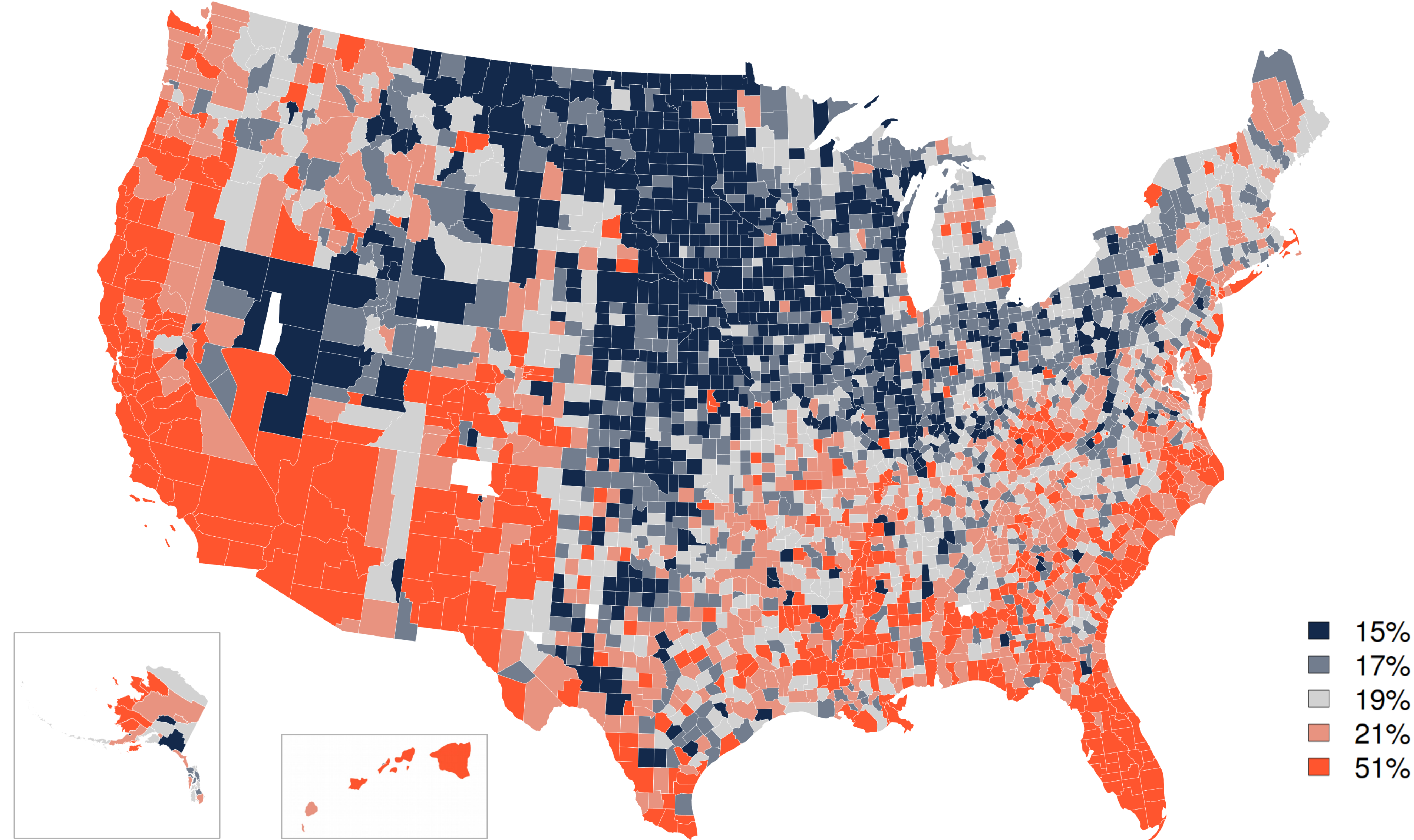

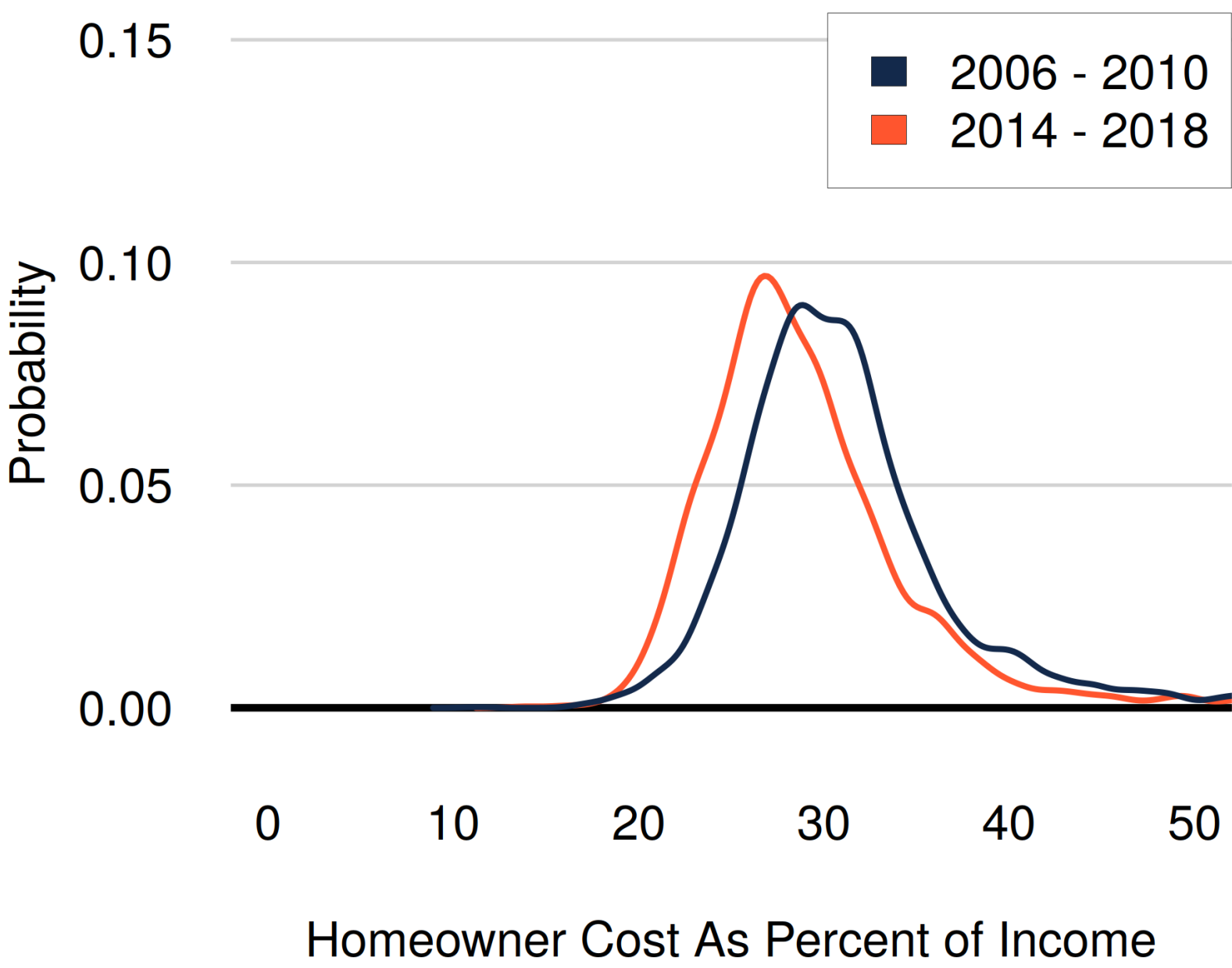
MEDIAN HOME OWNERSHIP COST AS A % OF MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME



MEDIAN RENT AS A % OF MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME



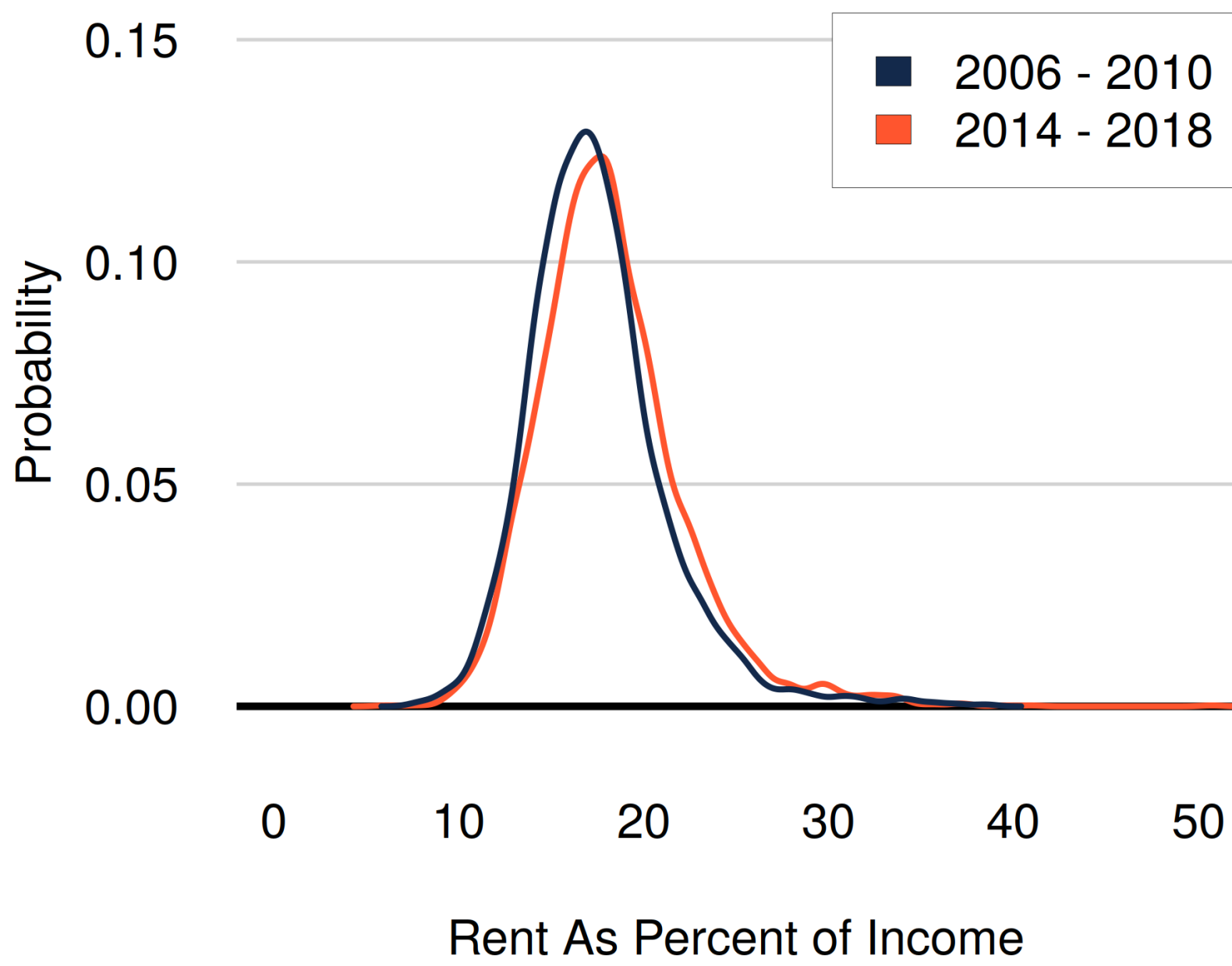
